What is the Foundation Stage?

The Foundation Stage begins when children reach the age of three, when children might attend a nursery setting.

- nursery setting.

 The final year of the Foundation Stage is when children are in a Reception class
 - This stage prepares the children for the rest of their school career.
- Our Reception children are organised in to key worker groups. This allows the children to build a strong relationship with an adult in the class so that they feel safe, secure, happy and able to learn.

Part time timetable - 3 weeks

Week 2 Morning sessions 8.45-11.45am Learning all of the morning routines and starting formal adult led activities (Phonic, Maths)

Week 3 Mornings and lunch 8.45-1.15pm Lunch will be in the hall with the class SMSA. Children will be sitting at the dinner table for 30 minutes before going outside for 30 minutes play.
